Autumn planting gives roots time to establish in still-warm soil, ready to thrive in spring. Whether you're growing food, flowers, or keeping your garden looking fresh, here's what you can do now:


Vegetable

- Spinach Cold-hardy and quick to grow. Best sown in September.
- · Winter lettuce (e.g. Arctic King, Winter Gem) Designed for cold seasons.
- Spring onions Sow now for early spring harvesting.
- Garlic Ideal to plant in late Sept-Nov. Plant individual cloves 2-3cm deep.

Flowers & Bulbs for UK Autumn Planting

- Spring bulbs (daffodils, crocuses, hyacinths) Classic UK autumn activity.
- Tulips -planted in late October to November to prevent tulip fire fungus.
